

HOW TO READ THE BOYS SCHEDULES

- Each team has its own row that displays all the opponents for the entire season.
- The time a team plays their home games is shown to the right of the team's name. This is their default start time. - If a game is to start at a time other than the default start time it is displayed under the opponents name in parentheses.
- **What determine if a game is an away game is the @ (at) symbol.**
EXAMPLE: @ Hemp 2 means this is an away game (but not for Hemp 2). The game is to be played at (@) Hemp 2.
- To find out what time Hemp 2 plays their home games scroll to Hemp 2's schedule (row) and look at their default start time.
- To find out where the game is to be played go to the 'Locations' page and scroll to Hemp 2's field locations/directions.

Examples Below:

Home Game

Sept 8 is a home game for CV1. MT 2 is the visiting team. Game time is 11:00.

Away Game

The Sept 15 game is an away game for CV1. **The game is at (@) Hemp 2.** (CV1 will need to travel to Hemp). You would need to scroll to Hemp 2's row to see what time Hemp 2 plays their home games.

Game Start Times

The default game start time for each team is shown in the 'Time' column. This is the time the team in the far left column (cell) plays their home games. CV1's home games start at 11:00 unless otherwise specified.

If a particular game's start time is different than the default time, this time is shown in parentheses under the team name. Example: Instead of the Oct 20 game starting at 11:00 the game would start at (1:00 pm). So EPH1 needs to be at CV1 for a 1:00 game.
